Chairman Stade called the meeting to order at 10:22 A.M.

Chairman Stade asked if any Officer had any issues, comments or corrections to the July 31, 2020 Board of Local Improvements meeting minutes as submitted. No comments were raised. RACM Kokat discussed Resolution No. 836 – Composite Connection Charges. All questions were addressed and satisfactorily answered.

Clerk Walsh moved and Vice Chairman McGoldrick seconded the motion to recommend approval of Resolution No. 836 – Composite Connection Charges to the Board of Trustees. Votes recorded: Walsh-Aye, McGoldrick-Aye and Stade-Aye. The motion carried.

RACM Kokat discussed Resolution No. 837 – Composite Connection Charges. All questions were addressed and satisfactorily answered.

Clerk Walsh moved and Vice Chairman McGoldrick seconded the motion to recommend approval of Resolution No. 837 – Composite Connection Charges to the Board of Trustees. Votes recorded: Walsh-Aye, McGoldrick-Aye and Stade-Aye. The motion carried.

Executive Director Liubicich discussed Resolution No. 775 - Authority to Advertise Contract 2020-03, Ginger Creek North Lift Station Improvements Project. All questions were addressed and satisfactorily answered.

Clerk Walsh moved and Vice Chairman McGoldrick seconded the motion to recommend approval of Resolution No. 775 – Authority to Advertise Contract 2020-03, Ginger Creek North Lift Station Improvements Project to the Board of Trustees. Votes recorded: Walsh-Aye, McGoldrick-Aye and Stade-Aye. The motion carried.

Executive Director Liubicich discussed Resolution No. 776 - Waiver of 3,000 Gallons Per Day Per Acre Limit for the Proposed GolfSocial-Lombard Development, Determining that No Portion of the Collection System has Inadequate Design Capacity During Dry Weather to Serve the Development and Authorization of Effluent in Excess of 3,000 Gallons Per Day Per Acre. All questions were addressed and satisfactorily answered.

Clerk Walsh moved and Vice Chairman McGoldrick seconded the motion to recommend approval of Resolution No. 776 – Waiver of 3,000 Gallons Per Day Per Acre Limit for the Proposed GolfSocial-Lombard Development, Determining that No Portion of the Collection System has Inadequate Design Capacity During Dry Weather to Serve the Development and Authorization of Effluent in Excess of 3,000 Gallons Per Day Per Acre to the Board of Trustees. Votes recorded: Walsh-Aye, McGoldrick-Aye and Stade-Aye. The motion carried.

Chairman Stade asked if there were any public comments on the issues presented on the Board of Local Improvement meeting's agenda or any other items. No public comments were presented.
