Chairman Stade called the meeting to order at 10:20 A.M.

Executive Director Liubicich discussed Resolution No. 791 - Request for Authority to Issue Change Order No. 2 in the amount of \$42,552.00, for Contract 2016-02, York Road Lift Station Improvement Project, thereby Increasing the Value of the Contract from \$1,690,176.00 to an Amount not to exceed \$1,732,728.00 and an Extension of Time to the Contract's Final Completion Date. All questions were addressed and satisfactorily answered.


Clerk Walsh moved and Vice Chairman McGoldrick seconded the motion to recommend approval of Resolution No. 791 – Request for Authority to Issue Change Order No. 2 in the amount of \$42,552.00, for Contract 2016-02, York Road Lift Station Improvement Project, thereby Increasing the Value of the Contract from \$1,690,176.00 to an Amount not to exceed \$1,732,728.00 and an Extension of Time to the Contract's Final Completion Date for submission to the Board of Trustees for approval. Votes recorded: Walsh-Aye, McGoldrick-Aye and Stade-Aye. The motion carried.

Chairman Stade asked if there were any public comments on the issues presented on the Board of Local Improvement meeting's agenda or any other items. No public comments were presented.
